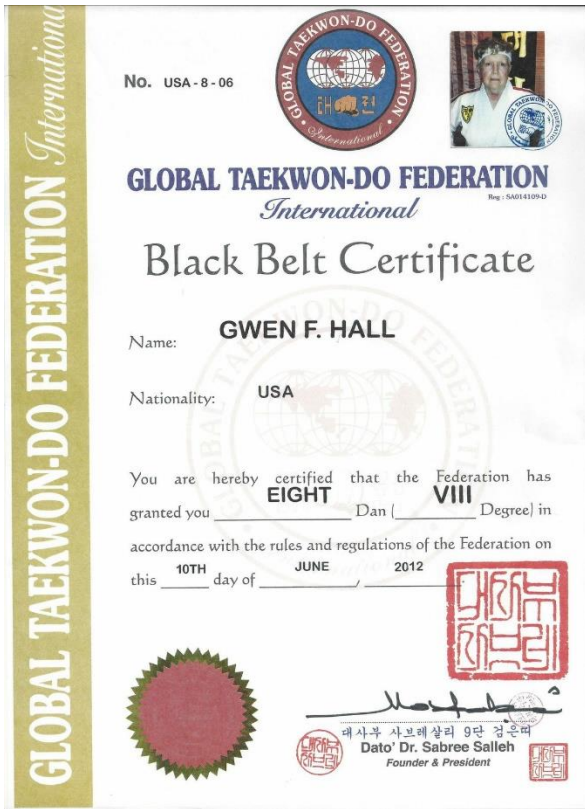

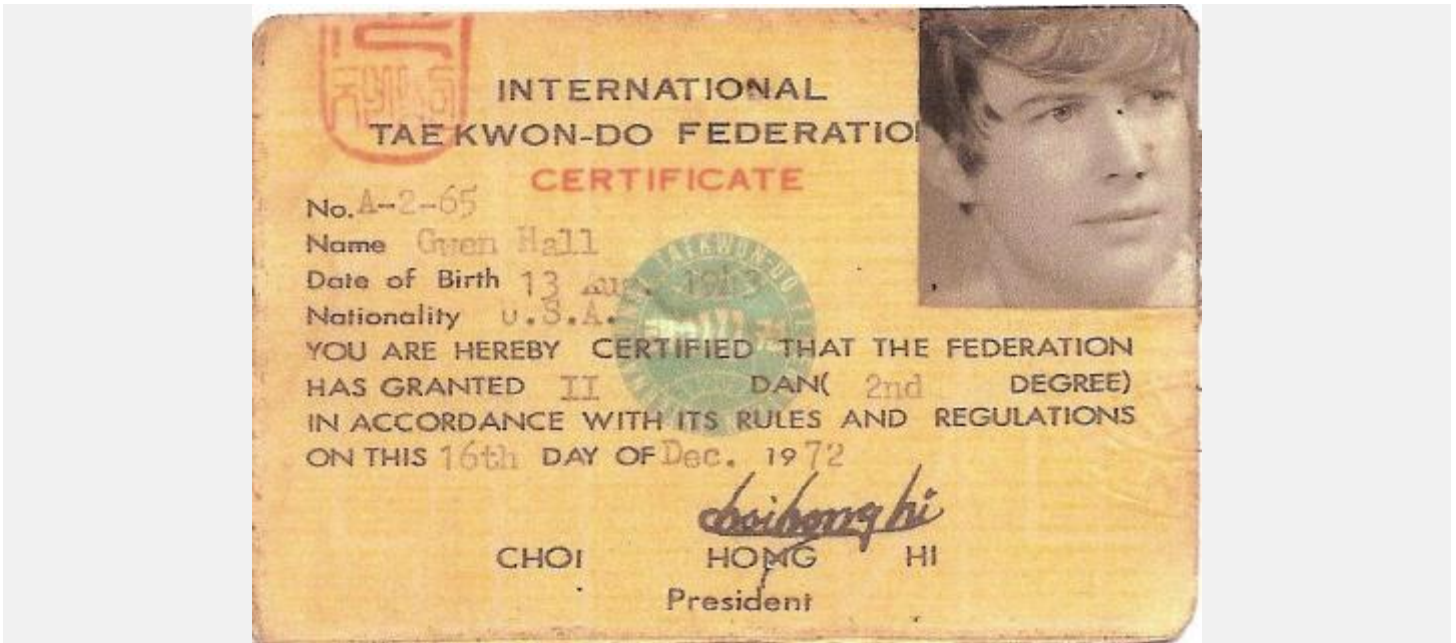


Kido Kwan Black Belt Card (front)

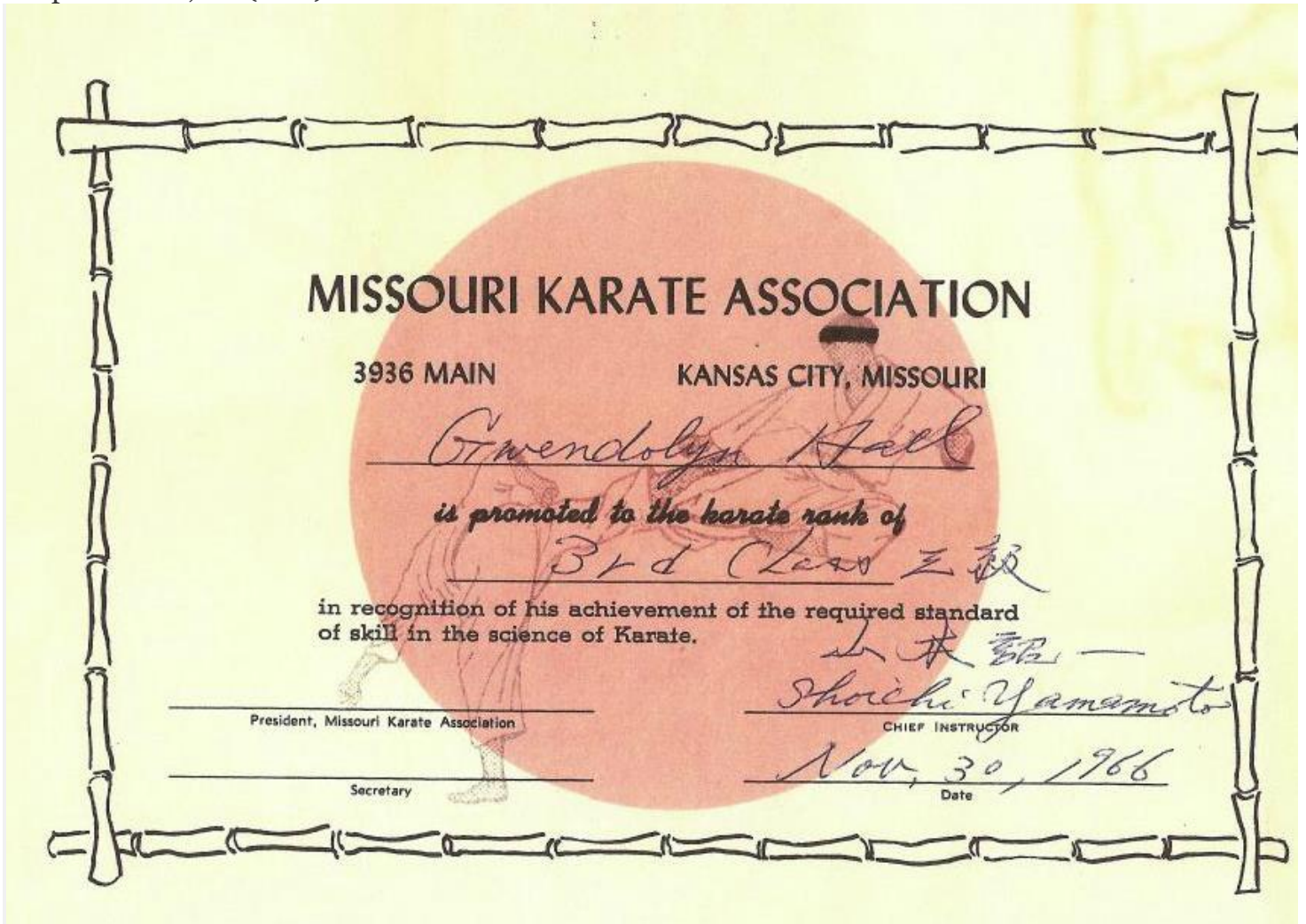

Master Hall has over 50 years of martial arts training and 45 Taekwon-Do instruction and has been actively teaching Taekwon-Do since 1971.

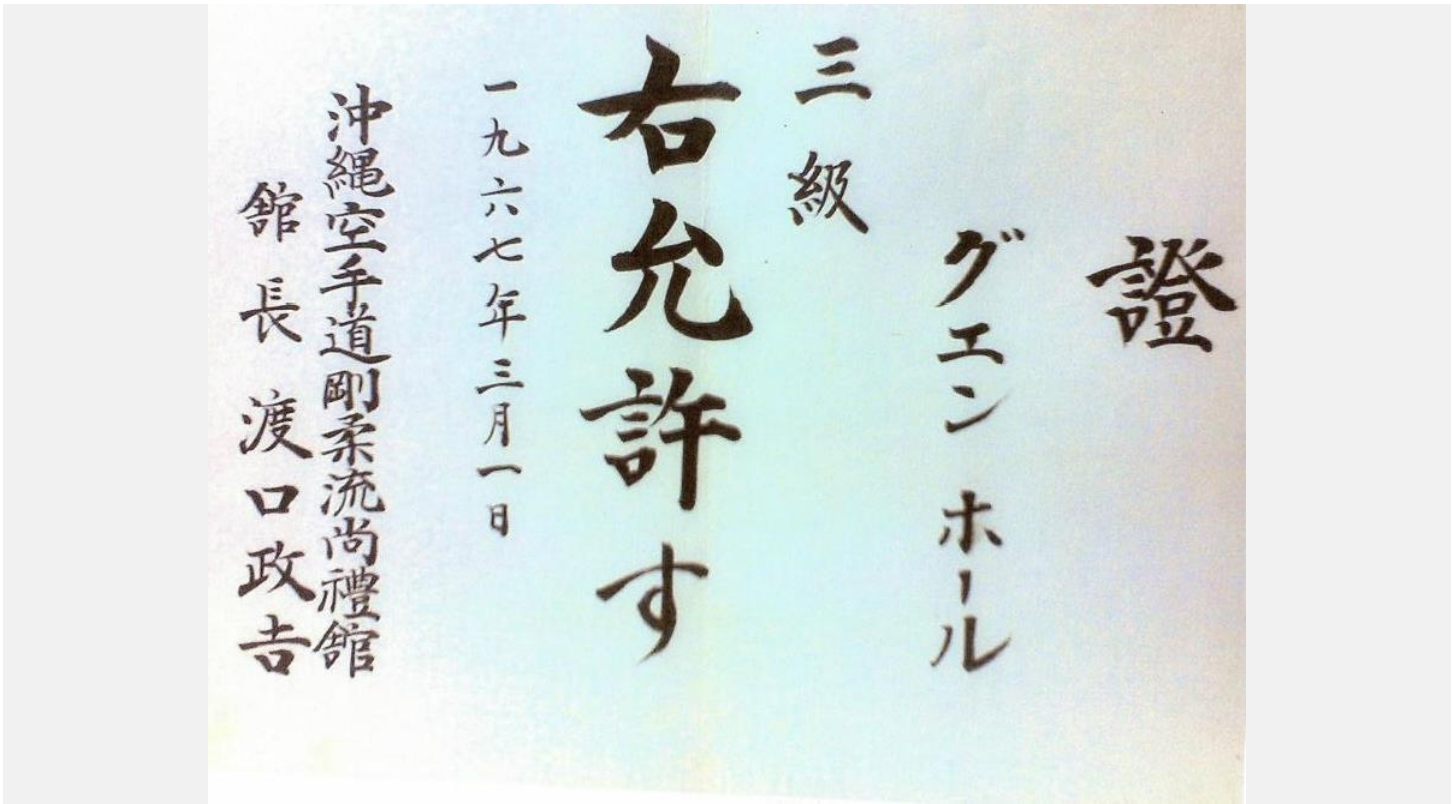


Master Hall in Corpus Christi Texas at a Black Belt promotion test December 2012

Gwen Hall honored by ITF

Gwen Hall, mentor of the Great Lakes Tae Kwon Do Club, was recently informed that she is the highest ranking woman in the International Tae Kwon Do Federation. The notification came shortly after Hall had been promoted to 4th Degree Black Belt.

Hall started training in Tae Kwon Do in 1963, while a student at the University of Kansas.

She has won several championships — most of them in men's Black Belt Light-weight Division. She was a pioneer in entering competitions based on rank and weight instead of by sex as was traditional until 1967 when she was the first woman to enter men's competition.

Hall has instructed U.S. Navy Seals (special forces); U.S. Marines; Lakehurst New Jersey Police Department; members of Naval Investigative Service; numerous YWCA and YMCA classes; as well as the classes on base.

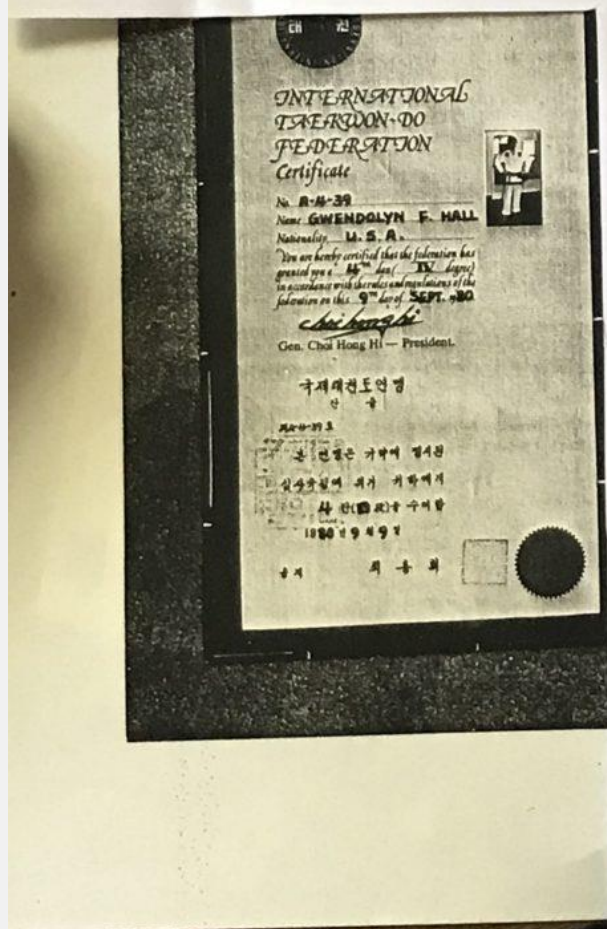
Lt. Hall is Director of Security for Naval Administrative Command.

Classes meet in Gym 500, topside Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 4:30 p.m., and usually last two hours. The majority of students come from Service School Command, both staff and students, but people from all commands are included. Dependents are also eligible to attend classes, as well as retired military and their dependents.

Hall, assisted by Mack Newton (4th Degree Black Belt) and Chris Paul (2nd Degree Black Belt) recently presided over testing for promotions of Great Lakes Tae Kwon Do enthusiasts.
